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TRAINING INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE TRAINEES AND/ORTRANSFERS

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE TRAINING PROGRAM

- ♦ Complete and return the enclosed NVFOA MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION, and check payable to "NVFOA" for \$65.00
- NVFOA Application Fee (\$75.00) covers membership fees and training materials.
- Conform to personal appearance requirements. Specific details of dress code and personal appearance requirements will be provided at the initial training session/orientation. Date and time to be determined.
- ♦ One of our initial meetings will be an "Orientation Session". It is designed to provide you with a detailed overview about football officiating in Northern Virginia, possibly address your questions in considerable detail and alleviate any fears you may have about embarking on a football officiating career. Additionally, you will be given the opportunity to meet [usually one on one] with an experienced regular member or Training Committee member to have dialogue about the NVFOA's expectations of you and what you should expect from the NVFOA.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Experienced officials transferring-in from another Association are required to attend a minimum of one (1) season of training to learn NVFOA mechanics and demonstrate their knowledge of National Federation rules and on-field officiating skills.
- New officials can expect to work regularly in Youth League, Freshman and Junior Varsity scholastic games. New officials who have no previous experience will generally not be assigned to Varsity games during the first year of training.

EARNINGS

- ♦ Game fees for Youth Leagues start at \$60 per official per game, usually in 2 or 3 game sets. Scholastic game fees range from \$75 to \$110 depending on the level (Freshman Junior Varsity Varsity), and the number of officials (three or four for sub-varsity games and four, five, six or seven for varsity games). Electric Clock Operators (ECOs) are also paid positions.
- ♦ You will be provided a complete Fee Schedule before the season begins.
- The Association deducts 11% from every official's game fees to defray Association operating expenses.
